

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council will conduct a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, August 10, 2021, at 6:00 p.m.**, or shortly thereafter, virtually via Zoom from the Council Chambers of Cotati City Hall, 201 West Sierra Avenue, to consider the following matters:

1. An ordinance to amend the land use zoning code to establish objective design standards for streamlined and ministerial multifamily developments in compliance with California Senate Bill 35, and modify the open space requirements for multifamily residential projects. The proposed ordinance would add Chapter 17-39 (Objective Design Standards for Streamlined and Ministerial Residential Projects) to the Cotati Municipal Code and amend Section 17.42.120 (Multifamily and Small Lot Single-Family Projects) and Chapter 17.90 (Definitions).
2. A resolution to establish Design Guidelines for telecommunication facilities on private property, and personal wireless service facilities (or small cells) and distributed antenna systems (DAS) added to street lights, traffic signals and utility poles (PG&E).

In conformance with California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Planning Division found that this project is consistent with the General Plan and its Final Environmental Impact Report and recommends that no further environmental review is required.
